<p>Site & Classroom counts: Sites and classrooms will be included in the PIR counts if there is at least one child enrolled on or after the Enrollment Begin Date in the location with a funding record matching a funding specified on the PIR Setup.</p> <p>Funded Enrollment counts: The Funded Enrollment count is taken from the classroom Funded Enrollment field located under Setup, Agency Configuration, and Program Info.</p> <p>Children: Children that were enrolled at any time during the PIR enrollment begin and end dates will be counted only once towards any question on the PIR. Additionally, they will only be included if their funding matches a funding selected on the PIR Setup. You can update the funding for a child by editing the enrollment details in the Enrollment module for the child, or by using the Entry Express – Enrollment utility to modify the funding for multiple children.</p> <p>Pregnant Women: Pregnant women will be included in the PIR if they meet the same criteria for children and they have a pregnancy record. The Employment Type field is located on the Employment tab of Personnel. • Staff must have an Initial Hire Date that is on or before the Enrollment Year End Date on the PIR Setup tab.
